Pro Tip: If you have both a Chase Freedom card and a Chase Sapphire card, transfer your Freedom points to your Sapphire account before booking travel. Your redemption value jumps from 1 cent per point to 1.25x or 1.5x automatically -- that can mean hundreds of dollars of extra value on a single trip.

How to Make Reservation Through Chase Travel: Step-by-Step for Every Booking Type

how to make reservation through chase travel is easier than most people expect. Follow these steps for each reservation type:

Booking a Flight Through Chase Travel

1. **Log into your Chase account** at chase.com using your username and password. Complete two-factor authentication if prompted.

11. **Save your confirmation email** which contains your booking reference number and PNR for the airline.

Booking a Hotel Through Chase Travel

The hotel booking process through Chase Travel follows a similar flow. From the Chase Travel homepage, select 'Hotels,' enter your destination, check-in and check-out dates, and number of guests. Browse available properties, compare room types, amenity listings, guest reviews, and cancellation policies. Select your room, choose payment method (card or points), complete guest details, and confirm.

Important: Chase Sapphire Reserve cardholders have access to the Chase Luxury Hotel and Resort Collection (LHRC) -- a curated portfolio of premium properties offering complimentary amenities like room upgrades, daily breakfast, and late checkout that are not available when booking directly with the hotel. Booking a Rental Car Through Chase Travel

Select 'Cars' from the Chase Travel navigation. Enter your pickup location, pickup date and time, return date and time, and driver age. Browse available vehicles from major rental companies (Enterprise, Hertz, Avis, Budget, National, etc.) filtered by car class, price, and amenities like GPS or child seats. Select your vehicle, review the rental terms and insurance options, choose payment method, and confirm.

Booking a Cruise Through Chase Travel

Chase Travel offers cruise bookings through its Cruises section. Select your preferred departure port, destination region (Caribbean, Mediterranean, Alaska, etc.), travel dates, and cabin type (Interior, Oceanview, Balcony, Suite). Important Things to Know Before You Make a Reservation Through Chase Travel

Cancellation and Refund Policies

Chase Travel passes through the cancellation and refund policies of the underlying supplier -- the airline, hotel, or rental company. Always read the specific cancellation policy on the booking review screen before confirming. Fully refundable bookings are ideal for trips where plans may change. Name Requirements on Bookings

When entering passenger or guest names, use exactly the legal name that appears on the government-issued ID or passport that will be used for travel. Even minor name discrepancies (initials vs. full first name, missing middle names) can cause issues at airport check-in or hotel front desks. Double-check every name field before confirming your reservation.

Points Redemptions Are Generally Non-Transferable

Reservations made with Ultimate Rewards points through the Chase Travel portal are tied to the cardholder's account. Points cannot be transferred between unrelated accounts after booking. If you are booking travel for another person, the reservation still flows through your Chase account, which is perfectly fine for gifting travel -- just ensure passenger details match that person's ID.

Booking Window and Advance Purchase

Chase Travel shows availability typically up to 11 months in advance for flights and up to 12 months for hotels, mirroring standard airline and hotel booking windows. For peak travel periods (major holidays, school breaks, popular events), booking early through the portal maximizes both availability and points value before prices rise.

Chase Travel vs. Direct Booking

Booking through Chase Travel means Chase (via Expedia's system) holds your reservation, not you directly with the airline or hotel. For flights, always retrieve your airline confirmation number from your Chase booking confirmation and check in directly with the airline 24 hours before departure. Common Mistakes to Avoid When Making a Reservation Through Chase Travel

- * **Not verifying with the airline after booking:** After completing a flight reservation through Chase Travel, always retrieve your airline PNR and check the booking on the airline's own website or app to confirm the reservation is fully ticketed.

On the flight or hotel search screen, increase the number of passengers or guests before searching. All travelers will need to have their details entered individually -- full legal name, date of birth, and Known Traveler Number (for TSA PreCheck).
